Fiscal Analysis

HB1387 increases the amount of time a person shall spend in DOC custody for violating provisions of this Act, as well as imposes a fine (some of which will go to the Department of Agriculture).

The imposed fine is "equal to three times the value of the animals or implement of husbandry that was stolen."

At this time, it is difficult to determine the effect said fines will have on the Department of Agriculture's revenue. However, it is prudent to note that said fines going to the Department of Agriculture would be subtracted/diverted from those usually received by the Courts.
