## **Research Analysis**

The measure modifies dates that elections to fill elective offices may be held by political subdivisions. The measure permits elections to be held on the following days:

- 1. The second Tuesday of February in any year;
- 2. The first Tuesday of April in any year;
- 3. The date of any regularly scheduled statewide state or federal election in an evennumbered year;
- 4. The second Tuesday of September in an odd-numbered year; and
- 5. The second Tuesday of November in an odd-numbered year.

The measure deletes obsolete language.
