## **Research Analysis**

**SB 313** establishes a process for electronic voter registration and authorizes the Secretary of the State Election Board to develop a system for the electronic transmission of voter registration applications from offices that provide public assistance programs or services to persons with disabilities and local motor license agencies.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure directs the Secretary of the State Election Board to establish a secure website to permit electronic voter registration. The State Election Board, in conjunction with the agency's software vendors, estimate a minimum cost to establish such a system at \$250,000, with potential maximum cost of approximately \$1,000,000, depending on program specifications and the level of customization that would be required for Oklahoma's voter registration system. Specifications would include a secure website, development of an interface with driver license information from the Department of Public Safety, and interface with the state's current voter registration system.
