Research Analysis

SB 313 establishes a process for electronic voter registration and authorizes the Secretary of the State Election Board to develop a system for the electronic transmission of voter registration applications from offices that provide public assistance programs or services to persons with disabilities and local motor license agencies.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure directs the Secretary of the State Election Board to establish a secure website to permit electronic voter registration. The State Election Board, in conjunction with the agency's software vendors, estimate a minimum cost to establish such a system at \$250,000, with potential maximum cost of approximately \$1,000,000, depending on program specifications and the level of customization that would be required for Oklahoma's voter registration system. Specifications would include a secure website, development of an interface with driver license information from the Department of Public Safety, and interface with the state's current voter registration system.
