Research Analysis

The conference committee substitute to SB 359 creates the Uninsured Vehicle Enforcement Program to be operated by the district attorneys in the state. The measure allows law enforcement to use automatic license plate reader systems to access and collect data to enforce Oklahoma's Compulsory Insurance Law. The measure provides that the program is not to be implemented until the Department of Public Safety verifies that at least 95% of the personal lines auto insurance market participates in the Compulsory Insurance Verification System and the Compulsory Insurance Verification System is updated in such a way to allow for the provisions of the program to be implemented without interrupting or impeding any other lawful uses of the system.
