SB 482 modifies the Hazardous Waste Management Act to ensure that hazardous waste that is temporarily staged at a disposal site during analysis is not considered disposed.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Upon review of SB 482, which clarifies that under state law, that the temporary staging of hazardous waste in a permitted unit while the waste is undergoing required testing is not considered to be *disposal* of the waste. It is determined, along with consultation from DEQ, to have no fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
