Research Analysis

The measure modifies the salaries of statewide elected officers by untying their salaries from judicial salaries. The bill would set the following salaries:

- Governor: \$147,000
- Lieutenant Governor: \$114,713
- Attorney General: \$132,825
- State Superintendent of Public Instruction: \$124,373
- Corporation Commission Members: \$114,713
- State Treasurer: \$114,713
- State Auditor and Inspector: \$114,713
- State Insurance Commissioner: \$114,713
- Commissioner of Labor: \$105,053

Fiscal Analysis

The measure decouples the salaries of certain statewide elected officials from those of certain judicial positions, and institutes salaries equivalent to the judicial salaries that were in effect for FY-14. Such salaries will be in effect for terms of office which begin in or after January 2016. As none of the salaries represents an increase, no additional appropriations are required and therefore do not impact state revenues.
