## **Research Analysis**

SB 706 delays the full implementation of the Teacher and Leader Effectiveness Evaluation System (TLE) until the 2017-2018 school year. The measure directs the State Board of Education, in consultation with the TLE Commission, to continue to study the implementation of the TLE. The measure provides school districts with the option of adopting an alternative percentage for teachers who have at least one tested grade or subject, on the quantitative portion of the TLE. Additionally, school districts will have the option of evaluating teachers previously employed by a different school district, or a teacher who enters into post-retirement employment, to evaluate the teacher based solely on the qualitative components of the TLE.
