**Fiscal Analysis**

According to officials with the Courts, “currently, the \$25 bond fee is only remitted to the Sheriff’s Jail Fund when a defendant is sentenced to the county jail. For defendants not sentenced to county jail, the bond fee is deposited into the court fund.

SB790 would require the bond fee to be remitted to the Sheriff’s Jail Fund, regardless of whether the defendant is sentenced to the county jail. This would result in a loss to the district courts of approximately \$1,606,179 annually.”
