**Research Analysis**

**SJR 30** would put to a vote of the people a constitutional amendment that, if approved, would restrict the Legislature to considering substantive measures in odd-numbered years only; however, such measures could be considered in even-numbered years if three-fourths of the members of each chamber vote to approve it.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure permits the Legislature to consider measures for appropriation in each Session and authorizes non-appropriations measures in odd-numbered year Sessions. Provision is also made for non-appropriations measures to be considered in even-numbered year Sessions subject to approval by a super-majority affirmative vote. No fiscal cost or cost saving is anticipated.
