**Research Analysis**

SJR 45 refers to a vote of the people a proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution that would, if approved, increase from eight to 12 years the length of time persons can serve in the office of Lieutenant Governor, State Auditor and Inspector, Attorney General, State Treasurer, Commissioner of Labor and Superintendent of Public Instruction.
