Fiscal Analysis

The CCR to SJR68 would authorize a vote of the people to allow single strength beer and wine to be sold in places other than liquor stores. Said retailers would have to comply with the law as it pertains to regulation, control, licensing and taxation of the manufacture, sale, distribution, possession, transportation and consumption of alcoholic beverages. Currently, the ABLE (Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement) Commission is the regulatory agency. It is assumed this will still be the case should the resolution become law.

The ABLE Commission generates approximately \$6.3 million per year through the application of their mission. The ABLE Commission receives approximately \$2.5 million of the revenue generated for the state.
