CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to child care; setting infant floor area requirements for existing and new facilities; providing for infant nutrition standards; requiring daily physical activity for children; eliminating screen time except in special occasions; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 405.4 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Licensed child care facilities opened or expanded before November 1, 2016, shall have thirty-five (35) square feet of floor area per infant in rooms occupied only by infants. New construction and existing space not previously licensed for child care after November 1, 2016, shall have forty (40) square feet of floor area per infant in rooms occupied only by infants.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 405.5 of Title 10, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 All licensed child care facilities shall:

5 1. Follow the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP)
6 nutrition standards for infants;

7 2. Provide children with opportunities for moderate and
8 vigorous physical activity for at least sixty (60) minutes per day
9 during a full-day program or thirty (30) minutes per day for a half-
10 day program including daily outdoor physical activity when possible,
11 and by providing infants daily opportunities to freely explore their
12 indoor and outdoor environments under adult supervision, including
13 engaging with infants on the ground each day to optimize adult-
14 infant interactions and providing daily tummy time, or time in the
15 prone position, for infants less than six (6) months of age; and

16 3. Eliminate screen time, including television, movies,
17 cellular phones, video games, computers and other digital devices,
18 for children under two (2) years of age except for special
19 occasions. Special occasions shall be limited to no more than
20 ninety (90) minutes once a week.

21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
