16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified								
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 405.4 of Title 10, unless there								
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:								
19	Licensed child care centers opened or expanded before November								
20	1, 2016, shall have thirty-five (35) square feet of floor area per								
21	infant in rooms occupied only by infants. New construction and								
22	existing space not previously licensed for child care after November								
23	1, 2016, shall have forty (40) square feet of floor area per infant								
24	in rooms occupied only by infants.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 405.5 of Title 10, unless there
 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 All licensed child care facilities shall:

5 1. Follow the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP)
6 nutrition standards for infants and children;

7 2. Provide children with opportunities for moderate and vigorous physical activity for at least sixty (60) minutes per day 8 9 during a full-day program or thirty (30) minutes per day for a half-10 day program, including daily outdoor time for physical activity when 11 possible, and by providing infants daily opportunities to freely 12 explore their indoor and outdoor environments under adult 13 supervision, including engaging with infants on the ground each day 14 to optimize adult-infant interactions and providing daily tummy 15 time, or time in the prone position, for infants less than six (6) 16 months of age; and

17 3. Eliminate screen time, including television, movies, 18 cellular phones, video games, computers and other digital devices, 19 for children under two (2) years of age. Limit screen time for 20 children two (2) years of age and older to less than thirty (30) 21 minutes per day for children in half-day programs or to less than 22 one (1) hour per day for children in full-day programs, except for 23 special occasions. Special occasions shall be limited to no more 24 than ninety (90) minutes once a week.
