1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2 2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
```

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 26 of Article II of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

Section 26. A. The <u>fundamental</u> right of a <u>each individual</u> citizen to keep and <u>to</u> bear arms <u>in defense of his home</u>, <u>person</u>, or <u>property</u>, <u>or</u>, including handguns, rifles, shotguns, nonlethal <u>defensive weapons</u> and other arms in common use, as well as <u>ammunition and the components of arms and ammunition</u>, for security, <u>self-defense</u>, lawful hunting and recreation, in aid of the civil power, when thereunto <u>legally lawfully</u> summoned, <u>or for any other</u> <u>legitimate purpose</u> shall <u>never not</u> be <u>prohibited</u>; <u>but nothing herein</u> <u>contained shall prevent the Legislature from regulating the carrying of weapons infringed by the state or by a political subdivision, agency or instrumentality thereof. Any regulation of this right shall be subject to strict scrutiny.</u>

B. This section shall not prevent the Legislature from prohibiting the possession of arms by convicted felons, those adjudicated as mentally incompetent or those who have been involuntarily committed in any mental institution.

C. No law shall impose registration or special taxation upon the keeping of arms, including the acquisition, ownership,

8	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:					
9	This measure amends the State Constitution. This measure					
10	addresses the right of a citizen to keep and bear arms. The					
11	changes to this section will make clear what types of weapons					
12	and for what purpose the weapons may be kept. It would state					
13	that the right to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed upon					
14	by the state and any regulations would be subject to strict					
15	scrutiny. The changes would also allow the state to prohibit					
16	certain persons from possessing arms. It would not allow the					
17	passage of laws that would require the registration of arms or					
18	special taxation of arms.
