23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES					
24	AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 13 to Article XXIII thereof, to read as follows:

No state employee may receive a salary in excess of one hundred twenty-five percent (125%) of the salary authorized to be paid to the Governor unless the salary is approved by the Oklahoma State Senate pursuant to a majority vote of those persons elected to and constituting that chamber. The provisions of this section shall be effective March 1, 2017, but shall be applicable to the salary of state employees hired prior to March 1, 2017.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It adds a new Section 13 to Article 23. It prohibits the payment of salary to any state employee which is greater than one hundred and twenty-five percent (125%) of the amount of salary paid to the Governor. It would allow an exception to this rule if a higher salary amount were approved by a majority vote of the Oklahoma
