7 An Act relating to special license plates;
8 amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last
9 amended by Section 3, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014
10 (47 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 1135.5), which
11 relates to special license plates for
12 demonstrating support; providing for special
13 plate for Oklahoma Educational Television
14 Authority; and providing an effective date.

15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, line 13, delete all of Section 1 and
16 insert a new Section 1 to read

17 "SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1113.4 of Title 47, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. No later than December 31, 2015, the Oklahoma Tourism and
21 Recreation Department shall choose the design for a new official
22 Oklahoma license plate in consultation with the following:

- 23 1. The Secretary of Commerce and Tourism;
- 24 2. The Secretary of Public Safety;
3. The Director of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority;
4. The Chairman of the Oklahoma Tax Commission; and

1 5. The Administrator of the Oklahoma Correctional Industries.

2 B. The design specifications chosen in accordance with
3 subsection A of this section shall be communicated to the Oklahoma
4 Tax Commission which shall implement the license plate reissue in
5 accordance with such design specifications at such time as the
6 Department of Public Safety requests a reissue pursuant to
7 subsection G of Section 1113.2 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
8 Statutes."

9
10 AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, line 13, delete all of Section 1 and
11 insert new Sections 1, 2 and 3 to read

12
13 "SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
14 last amended by Section 14 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 831 of the
15 1st Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
16 follows:

17 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
18 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
19 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
20 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
21 subject as provided by this section.

22 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
23 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
24 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
2 registered for the current year.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
4 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
5 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
6 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
7 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
8 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
9 issued on a staggered system.

10 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
11 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
12 applications for special license plates authorized under this
13 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
14 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
15 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
16 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
17 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
18 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
19 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
20 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
21 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

22 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
23 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
24 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of

1 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
2 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
3 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
4 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
5 removed from the vehicle.

6 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
7 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
8 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
9 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications
10 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
11 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
12 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
13 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
14 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
15 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

16 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
17 follows:

18 1. Round and Square Dance License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
20 round and square dancing;

21 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
22 License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
23 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
24 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

1 3. National Rifle Association License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
3 Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
4 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
5 Association;

6 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
8 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
9 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
10 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
11 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
12 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
13 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
14 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
15 contain the Masonic emblem;

16 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
17 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for
18 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
19 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
20 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
21 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
22 contain the Shriner's emblem;

1 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
3 ballooning in this state;

4 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall
5 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
6 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
7 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
8 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
9 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
10 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
11 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
12 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
13 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

14 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
16 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
17 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
19 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
20 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
21 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
22 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
23 Columbus emblem;
24

1 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
2 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
3 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

5 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying
7 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag
8 membership in Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed
9 in consultation with Ducks Unlimited;

10 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
12 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
13 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
14 consultation with Kiwanis International;

15 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
17 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
18 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
19 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
20 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
21 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
22 Accountants;

23 13. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate

1 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
2 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
3 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
4 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
5 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
6 emergency management department head;

7 14. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates
8 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
9 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
10 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
11 Conservation Corps;

12 15. Rotarian License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
13 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
14 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
15 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
16 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
17 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
18 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
19 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
20 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

21 16. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
23 by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and issued to any
24

1 resident of this state who is a member of the Benevolent Protective
2 Order of Elks;

3 17. Humane Society License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
6 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
7 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
8 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

9 18. Oklahoma Mustang Club - such plates shall be designed,
10 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission, by the
11 Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this state who
12 is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons may apply
13 for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon presentment of proof
14 of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club. The plates shall be
15 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
16 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates;

17 19. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plates - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
19 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
20 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
21 consultation with American Business Clubs;

22 20. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plates - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
24 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States

1 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
2 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
3 Oklahoma;

4 21. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in
7 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

8 22. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plates - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public
12 School System;

13 23. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plates - such
14 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of
15 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the
16 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

17 24. Parrothead Club License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead
19 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any
20 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as
21 for personalized license plates;

22 25. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plates - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the
24

1 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed
2 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

3 26. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
5 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed
6 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's
7 Association;

8 27. Alpha Kappa Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa
10 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
11 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha
12 Sorority;

13 28. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License
14 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
15 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and
16 fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council
17 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
18 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council
19 Incorporated;

20 29. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and
22 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license
23 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department
24 of Health;

1 30. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
3 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.
4 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central
5 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

6 31. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated
7 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
8 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community
9 Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall be
10 designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders of
11 America Incorporated;

12 32. Delta Sigma Theta License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma
14 Theta Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority
16 Incorporated;

17 33. Omega Psi Phi License Plate - such plates shall be designed
18 and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi
19 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
20 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Incorporated;

21 34. Alpha Phi Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha
23 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
24

1 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity
2 Incorporated;

3 35. 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System of Highways
4 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
5 wishing to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System
6 of Highways. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
7 with the American Association of State Highway and Transportation
8 Officials;

9 36. Kappa Alpha Psi License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi
11 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
12 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity
13 Incorporated;

14 37. Sigma Gamma Rho License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Sigma Gamma Rho
16 Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
17 the Oklahoma Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Incorporated.
18 Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Sigma
19 Gamma Rho License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,
20 2013;

21 38. Multiple Sclerosis License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
23 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates
24

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
2 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

3 39. Frederick Douglass High School License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.
6 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of
7 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

8 40. United States Air Force Academy License Plates - such
9 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
10 demonstrate support for the United States Air Force Academy;

11 41. In God We Trust License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

14 42. National Weather Center License Plate - such plates shall
15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
16 for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with representatives of the National
18 Weather Center Directors;

19 43. Make-A-Wish Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
21 the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Make-A-Wish
23 Foundation;

1 44. South Central Section PGA Foundation License Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the South Central Section PGA Foundation.
4 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the South
5 Central Section PGA Foundation;

6 45. Putnam City High School License Plate - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
8 for Putnam City High School. The plates shall be designed in
9 consultation with representatives of Putnam City High School Alumni
10 Association, Inc.;

11 46. Autism Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness of
13 autism. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
14 the Oklahoma Autism Network;

15 47. Oklahoma Blood Institute License Plate - such plates shall
16 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
17 for the Oklahoma Blood Institute. The license plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Blood Institute;

19 48. Zeta Phi Beta and Phi Beta Sigma License Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of
21 Zeta Phi Beta Sorority or Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. The license
22 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapters
23 of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Incorporated and Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity
24 Incorporated;

1 49. Star Spencer High School License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for Star Spencer High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates
4 shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the Star
5 Spencer High School Alumni Association. Subject to the provisions
6 of subsection A of this section, the Star Spencer High School
7 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

8 50. Northeast High School License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
10 Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates shall be
11 designed in consultation with representatives of the Northeast High
12 School Alumni Association;

13 51. Oklahoma City Central High School License Plate - such
14 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
15 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
16 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with
17 representatives of the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
18 Association;

19 52. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
20 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for music
21 festivals held in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa,
22 Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
23 the Greenwood Cultural Center;
24

1 53. Oklahoma Rifle Association License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the Oklahoma Rifle Association. The plates shall be
4 designed in consultation with representatives of the Oklahoma Rifle
5 Association;

6 54. Oklahoma City Thunder License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Oklahoma City Thunder. The license plate shall be designed in
9 consultation with the Oklahoma City Thunder organization;

10 55. Ovarian Cancer Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
11 be designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
12 of ovarian cancer. The license plate shall be designed in
13 consultation with the HOPE in Oklahoma organization;

14 56. BMW Car Club of America License Plate - such plates shall
15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
16 for the BMW Car Club of America. The plates shall be issued to any
17 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
18 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
19 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Sunbelt Chapter of
20 the BMW Car Club of America. Subject to the provisions of
21 subsection A of this section, the BMW Car Club of America License
22 Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2013;

23 57. Don't Tread On Me License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem

1 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden
2 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

4 58. Oklahomans for the Arts License Plate - such plates shall
5 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
6 for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts education.
7 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahomans for the
8 Arts;

9 59. Oklahoma City Barons License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
11 the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization. The
13 license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
14 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

15 60. Oklahoma City Redhawks License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
17 the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks organization;

19 61. Tulsa Shock License Plate - such plates shall be designed
20 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
21 Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
22 with the Tulsa Shock organization;

23 62. Tulsa Oilers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
24 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the

1 Tulsa Oilers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
2 with the Tulsa Oilers organization;

3 63. Tulsa Drillers License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Tulsa Drillers. The license plate shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Tulsa Drillers organization;

7 64. Millwood School District License Plate - such plates shall
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
9 for the Millwood School District. The license plate shall be
10 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood School
11 District;

12 65. Booker T. Washington High School License Plate - such
13 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
14 Booker T. Washington High School and shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Booker T. Washington High School National
16 Alumni Association;

17 66. Oklahoma Current State Flag License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag and
19 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the current
20 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
21 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

22 67. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and
24 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original

1 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
2 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

3 68. Tulsa 66ers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
5 Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the
6 Tulsa 66ers Organization;

7 69. Jenks Trojans License Plate - such plates shall be issued
8 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for Jenks School District
9 and shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the
10 Jenks School District; and

11 70. Frederick Bombers License Plate - such plates shall be
12 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Frederick
13 School District and shall be designed in consultation with
14 representatives of the Frederick School District.

15 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
16 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by
17 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise
18 provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows:
19 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be
20 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
21 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
22 Registration Act and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the
23 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
24 Section 1104 of this title.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
2 last amended by Section 16 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 831 of the
3 1st Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
4 follows:

5 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
6 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
7 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
8 financial assistance as provided by this section.

9 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
10 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
11 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
12 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
13 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

14 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
15 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
16 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
17 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
18 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
19 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
20 issued on a staggered system.

21 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
22 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
23 applications for special license plates authorized under this
24 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's

1 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
2 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
3 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
4 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
5 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
6 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
7 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

9 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
10 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
11 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
12 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
13 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
14 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
15 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
16 removed from the vehicle.

17 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
18 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
19 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
20 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
21 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
22 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
23 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
24

1 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
2 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
4 follows:

5 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
8 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
9 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

10 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
11 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
12 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
14 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
15 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
16 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
18 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
19 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
20 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
21 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
22 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
23 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
24

1 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
2 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

3 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
4 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.

5 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
6 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
7 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
8 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.

9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
10 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
11 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
12 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
13 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
15 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
16 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
17 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

19 ~~Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend~~
20 ~~"Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more~~
21 ~~than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.~~
22 ~~Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese~~
23 ~~Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color~~
24 ~~Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word~~

1 ~~"Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for~~
2 ~~motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new~~
3 ~~design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle~~
4 ~~license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design~~
5 ~~requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other~~
6 ~~than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each~~
7 ~~succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.~~

8 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
9 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
10 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
11 the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living Memorial;

12 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
14 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
16 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
17 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
18 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
19 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
20 plates.

21 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
22 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
23 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
24

1 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
3 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
4 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
5 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the prevention of child abuse.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
8 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

9 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
10 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
12 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
13 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
14 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
15 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
16 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
17 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
18 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
19 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
20 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
21 issued;

22 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
24 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee

1 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
2 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

3 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
5 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
6 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
7 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
8 Oklahoma;

9 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
11 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
12 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
13 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
14 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
15 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

16 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
18 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
19 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
20 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
21 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
22 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
23 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
24 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician

1 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
2 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
5 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
6 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
7 Revolving Fund;

8 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
9 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
12 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
14 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
15 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
16 provide services to crime victims;

17 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
20 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
22 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
23 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
24 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

1 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
2 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
3 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
4 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
5 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
6 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
7 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
8 Section 1104.4 of this title;

9 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
11 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
12 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
13 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
14 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
15 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
16 Section 1104.3 of this title;

17 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
19 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
20 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
22 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
23 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
24

1 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
2 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
5 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
6 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
8 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
9 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
10 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
11 follows:

- 12 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
13 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 14 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
15 Education Revolving Fund,
- 16 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
17 Career Technology Fund, and
- 18 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
19 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
20 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
21 Oklahoma Statutes.

22 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
23 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
24 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be

1 apporportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
2 paragraph;

3 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
4 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
5 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
6 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
7 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
8 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
9 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
10 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
11 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
12 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
13 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
14 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
15 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
16 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
17 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
18 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
19 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
20 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

21 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
22 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
23 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
24 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters

1 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
2 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
3 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
4 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
5 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
6 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
7 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
8 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

9 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
10 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
11 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
12 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
13 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
14 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
16 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
17 of this title;

18 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
19 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
20 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
21 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
22 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
23 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
24

1 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
2 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

3 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
4 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
5 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
6 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
7 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
8 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
9 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
10 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
11 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
12 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
13 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
14 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
15 specifically for created families;

16 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
17 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
18 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
19 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
20 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
21 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
22 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
23 this title;
24

1 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
4 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
6 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
7 Section 1104.7 of this title;

8 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
9 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
10 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
11 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
12 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
13 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
14 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
15 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
16 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
17 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
18 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
19 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

20 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
22 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
23 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
24 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's

1 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
2 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
3 Section 1104.8 of this title;

4 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
5 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
6 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
7 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
8 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
9 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
10 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
11 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
12 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
13 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
14 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
15 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
16 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
17 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
18 plate issued;

19 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
21 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
22 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
23 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
24 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon

1 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
2 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
3 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
4 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
5 plate issued;

6 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
8 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
9 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
10 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

11 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
12 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
13 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
14 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
15 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
16 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
17 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
18 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

19 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
21 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
22 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
24 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the

1 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
2 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
3 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
4 Section 1104.10 of this title;

5 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
7 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
8 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
9 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
10 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
11 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
12 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
13 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

14 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
15 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
16 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
17 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
18 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
19 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
20 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
21 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
22 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
23 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -
2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
4 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
5 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
6 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
7 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
8 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
9 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
10 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
11 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
16 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp.
17 2014, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
19 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
20 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
21 financial assistance as provided by this section.

22 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
23 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
24 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
2 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
3 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
4 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
5 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
6 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
7 issued on a staggered system.

8 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
9 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
10 applications for special license plates authorized under this
11 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
12 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
13 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
14 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
15 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
16 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
17 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
18 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
19 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

20 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates

17 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.

19 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
20 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
21 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
22 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency

1 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
2 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
4 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
5 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
6 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
7 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician
8 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
9 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
12 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
13 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
14 Revolving Fund;

15 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
16 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
18 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
19 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
20 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
21 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
22 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
23 provide services to crime victims;
24

1 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
4 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
6 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
7 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
8 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

9 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
10 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
11 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
12 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
13 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
14 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
15 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
16 Section 1104.4 of this title;

17 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
18 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
19 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
20 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
21 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
22 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
23 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
24 Section 1104.3 of this title;

1 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
3 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
4 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
6 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
7 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
8 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
9 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
12 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
13 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
14 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
15 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
16 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
17 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
18 follows:

- 19 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
20 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 21 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
22 Education Revolving Fund,
- 23 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
24 Career Technology Fund, and

1 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
2 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
3 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
4 Oklahoma Statutes.

5 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
6 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
7 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
8 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
9 paragraph;

10 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
11 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
12 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
13 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
14 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
15 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
16 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
17 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
18 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
19 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
20 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
21 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
22 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
23 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
24 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired

1 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
2 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
3 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

4 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
6 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
7 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
8 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
9 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
10 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
11 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
12 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
13 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
14 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
15 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

16 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
17 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
18 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
19 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
20 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
21 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
22 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
23 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
24 of this title;

1 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
3 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
5 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
6 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
7 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
8 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

9 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
10 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
11 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
12 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
13 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
14 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
15 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
16 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
17 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
18 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
19 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
20 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
21 specifically for created families;

22 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
23 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
24 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of

1 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
2 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
3 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
4 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
5 this title;

6 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
9 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
10 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
11 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
12 Section 1104.7 of this title;

13 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
14 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
15 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
16 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
17 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
19 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
20 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
21 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
22 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
23 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
24 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

1 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
4 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
5 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
6 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
7 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
8 Section 1104.8 of this title;

9 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
10 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
12 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
13 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
14 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
15 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
16 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
17 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
18 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
19 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
20 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
21 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
22 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
23 plate issued;
24

1 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
4 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
5 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
6 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
7 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
8 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
9 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
10 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
14 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
15 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
16 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

17 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
18 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
19 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
20 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
21 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
22 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
23 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
24 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

1 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
4 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
5 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
6 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
7 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
8 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
9 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
10 Section 1104.10 of this title;

11 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
13 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
14 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
15 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
16 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
17 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
18 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
19 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

20 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
21 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
22 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
23 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
24 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on

1 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
2 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
3 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
4 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
5 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -
7 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
9 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
10 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
11 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
12 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
13 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
14 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
15 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
16 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
17 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
18 plate issued;

19 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall
20 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
21 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be
22 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse
23 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
24

1 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
2 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

3 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
6 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
7 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
8 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
9 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
10 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
11 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

12 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
14 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
15 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
16 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
17 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this
18 title;

19 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
20 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
21 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
22 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
23 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
24 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be

1 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
2 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

3 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
6 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
7 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
8 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
9 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
10 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
11 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
12 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
14 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
15 each license plate issued;

16 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
17 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
18 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization
19 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal
20 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and
21 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military
22 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in
23 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan.
24 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of

1 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. The plate shall
2 be designed in consultation with Folds of Honor Incorporated and
3 shall contain the official Folds of Honor Incorporated logo which
4 includes the mark "Folds of Honor" across the bottom of the plate.
5 The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing
6 agreement with Folds of Honor Incorporated for any licensing fees
7 which may be required in order to use the Folds of Honor
8 Incorporated logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
9 for a payment to Folds of Honor Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars
10 (\$25.00) for each license plate issued;

11 41. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
13 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
14 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
15 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
16 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
17 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
18 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
19 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if
20 necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Downed
21 Bikers Association for any licensing fees which may be required in
22 order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
23 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers
24

1 Association of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
2 license plate;

3 42. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation
5 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.

6 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the
7 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the
8 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
9 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this
10 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
11 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title
12 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13 43. Buffalo Soldier License Plate - such plates shall be issued
14 to any person wishing to honor and celebrate the history and
15 contribution of the Buffalo Soldiers. The license plates shall be
16 designed in consultation with the Lawton-Fort Sill Chapter of the
17 Buffalo Soldiers 9th and 10th (Horse) Cavalry Association. As
18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 deposited in the Buffalo Soldier License Plate Revolving Fund
20 created in Section 1104.16 of this title;

21 44. Prevent Blindness Oklahoma License Plate - such plates
22 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
23 for vision screening of school age children in this state. The
24 license plates shall be designed in consultation with Prevent

1 Blindness Oklahoma. As provided in this section, an amount of the
2 fee collected shall be deposited in the Prevent Blindness Oklahoma

7 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.
8 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
9 University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer Research Fund.
10 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
11 deposited in the Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate Revolving
12 Fund created in Section 1104.19 of this title;

13 48. Alzheimer's Research License Plate - such plates shall be
14 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
15 Oklahoma Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association. The license plates
16 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
17 Alzheimer's Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
18 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Alzheimer's Research
19 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.20 of this
20 title;

21 49. Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate - such plates
22 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
23 for the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. The
24 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma

1 Hospice and Palliative Care Association. As provided in this
2 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
3 Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate Revolving Fund created in

5 50. Juvenile Diabetes Research License Plate - such plates
6 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
7 for the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
8 Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
9 with the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
10 Foundation. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee

14 51. Deer Creek Schools Foundation License Plate - such plates
15 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
16 for the Deer Creek Schools Foundation. The license plates shall be

18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be

20 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.23 of this title;

21 52. Lupus Awareness and Education License Plate - such plates
22 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
23 for the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be
24 designed in consultation with the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. As

1 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
2 deposited in the Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund created

4 53. Chiefs of Police License Plate - such plates shall be
5 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the

7 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs

9 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs
10 of Police License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1 of this

12 54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
14 support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City.

7 56. Oklahoma Educational Television Authority License Plate -
8 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

11 Authority. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
12 collected shall be deposited in the Educational Television Authority
13 Revolving Fund created in Section 156 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma

15 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
16 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
17 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The

19 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
