B. Upon the failure of the Legislature to comply with subsection A of this section, the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall cause to be presented directly to the entire House of Representatives the Governor's budget bill which upon approval by the House shall immediately proceed to the Senate for a vote on final passage without amendment. For the purposes of this section, "Governor's budget bill" shall mean legislation that substantially reflects the budget proposal presented to the Legislature by the Governor.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
