SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, the sum of One Hundred Ten Million Forty-four Thousand Three Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$110,044,319.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to replace federal financial participation expenditures, to be distributed to Oklahoma State University and the University of Oklahoma for the benefit of the Deans Graduate Medical Education Program, in the same ratio as such funds were provided for such purpose by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority in fiscal year 2017.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
