PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;  
imposing restriction related to payment of salaries  
of troopers; imposing restriction related to  
furloughs or related actions; prohibiting imposition  
of limits on fuel consumption and related  
restrictions related to use of vehicles provided by  
the Department of Public Safety; providing for  
noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the Oklahoma  
Department of Public Safety shall not reduce the salary of any state  
trooper which was in effect on July 1, 2017, or impose furloughs  
with respect to any state trooper or take any other action to reduce

1 the total time a state trooper who was employed as of July 1, 2017,  
2 is available for the performance of law enforcement duties.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
4 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

5 For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the Oklahoma  
6 Department of Public Safety shall not impose restrictions on the  
7 number of miles which vehicles provided by the Department of Public  
8 Safety and driven by state troopers may travel and shall not reduce  
9 the amount of fuel available for consumption by such vehicles or in  
10 any other manner restrict the range of travel by such vehicles.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
12 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
