PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011, Section 1-101, which relates to general elections; providing for referral of certain measures to ballot; providing for referral of measures containing modifications to the Oklahoma Constitution; providing for referral of measures containing modifications to the Oklahoma Statutes; authorizing general election for specific measures referred by Legislature; designating certain date in March for general election; providing for applicability of definitions of general election; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 1-101, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-101. A. On the first Tuesday succeeding the first Monday of November, 1976, and every four (4) years thereafter, a General Election shall be held, at which time electors for President and Vice President shall be elected. On said date, and every two (2) years thereafter, United States Senators and United States

1 Representatives, whose terms expire before the next succeeding
2 General Election, and state, district and county officers, whose
3 terms expire before the next succeeding General Election, shall be
4 elected. No county, municipality or school district shall schedule
5 an election on any date during the twenty (20) days immediately
6 preceding the date of any such General Election.

7 B. Beginning with the first Tuesday succeeding the first Monday
8 in March, 2018, and upon the first Tuesday succeeding the first
9 Monday of every March in even-numbered years thereafter, there may
10 be conducted a General Election for purposes of submitting proposed
11 amendments to the Oklahoma Constitution, in such form as may be
12 contained in the legislative measure which refers the proposal to
13 the ballot, and for submitting proposed additions, amendments,
14 repeals, recodifications or other changes to the Oklahoma Statutes,
15 in such form as may be contained in the legislative measure which
16 refers the proposal to the ballot. Any measure making a referral of
17 changes to the Oklahoma Constitution or the Oklahoma Statutes at the
18 General Election shall specify whether the measure is to be voted
19 upon at the General Election as defined in this subsection or the
20 General Election as defined in subsection A of this section to be
21 held in November of the applicable year. The provisions of this
22 subsection shall only be applicable for purposes of defining the
23 term "General Election" with respect to the measures referring
24 proposals for modifications to the Oklahoma Constitution or the

1 Oklahoma Statutes described by this subsection and shall not be
2 applicable for any other purpose. For all other purposes, the
3 definition of "General Election" contained in subsection A of this
4 section shall be used for determinations of the date of a General
5 Election.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
