B. Beginning with the first Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in March, 2018, and upon the first Tuesday succeeding the first Monday of every March in even-numbered years thereafter, there may be conducted a General Election for purposes of submitting proposed amendments to the Oklahoma Constitution, in such form as may be contained in the legislative measure which refers the proposal to the ballot, and for submitting proposed additions, amendments, repeals, recodifications or other changes to the Oklahoma Statutes, in such form as may be contained in the legislative measure which refers the proposal to the ballot. Any measure making a referral of changes to the Oklahoma Constitution or the Oklahoma Statutes at the General Election shall specify whether the measure is to be voted upon at the General Election as defined in this subsection or the General Election as defined in subsection A of this section to be held in November of the applicable year. The provisions of this subsection shall only be applicable for purposes of defining the term "General Election" with respect to the measures referring proposals for modifications to the Oklahoma Constitution or the
