PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to children; directing the Department of Human Services to disseminate information when a child is eligible for adoption; authorizing reimbursement of expenses incurred in completed adoption; proving for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-7-116 of Title 10A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. When a child in the custody of the Department of Human Services becomes eligible for adoption and the child needs a permanent placement, the Department shall notify and disseminate information about the child to child-placing agencies that have requested in writing to receive such notice in order to locate a possible prospective adoptive parent for the child.

B. Upon completion of an adoption specified in subsection A of this section, the Department may provide reimbursement of expenses

1 incurred by the child-placing agency for recruiting, training,
2 conducting a home study and providing postplacement supervision for
3 the adoptive parent.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
