SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 40-126 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall work in cooperation with business entities, nonprofit organizations and foundations in order to manage privately donated funds to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
