15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:					
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 36-113, as					
17	amended by Section 1, Chapter 129, O.S.L. 2012 (11 O.S. Supp. 2015,					
18	Section 36-113), is amended to read as follows:					
19	Section 36-113. A. The Department of Transportation may, or					
20	the board of county commissioners of any county or federally					
21	recognized tribal government shall, by agreement with the governing					
22	body of a municipality having a population of less than five					
23	thousand (5,000) persons, construct, improve, repair or maintain any					
24	of the streets of the municipality.

B. The board of county commissioners may construct, improve, repair, or maintain any of the streets of a municipality having a population of less than five thousand (5,000) persons subject to agreement between the governing bodies of the county and the municipality without regard to whether the municipality has passed a sales tax with proceeds earmarked to construct, improve, repair or maintain any of the streets or roadways of such municipality.

- C. The board of county commissioners may construct, improve, repair or maintain any of the streets of a municipality having a population of greater than five thousand (5,000) persons but less than fifteen thousand (15,000) persons if the municipality has passed a sales tax with the proceeds earmarked to construct, improve, repair or maintain any of the streets or roadways of such municipality; provided, that the population cap provided in this subsection shall not apply and the board of county commissioners may construct, improve, repair or maintain any of the streets of a municipality with a population of more than fifteen thousand (15,000) persons if the county determines the construction, improvement, repair or maintenance is necessary or desirable to promote or ensure public safety or encourage, develop or promote commerce.
- D. The board of county commissioners may construct, improve, repair, or maintain any of the streets of a municipality if the county has a population in excess of five hundred thousand (500,000)
