16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified				
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-187.1 of Title 70, unless				
18	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:				
19	A. The State Department of Education shall be required to				
20	publish an annual report which contains the following information				
21	regarding the issuance of emergency certificates for the preceding				
22	school year:				
23	1. The total number of emergency certificates issued in the

- 2. An identification number for each teacher who received an emergency certificate in the state;
- 3. For each teacher identified in paragraph 2 of this subsection:
 - a. the school district in which he or she was assigned,
 - b. the specific school in which he or she was assigned,
 - c. demographic information including student poverty levels, racial composition, and disability percentages at the specific school in which he or she was assigned, and
 - d. the subject matter taught; and
- 4. The total time period in which he or she taught under an emergency certificate.
- B. The report shall be made available by June 30 of each year for the next five (5) years on the Department's website.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
