  - B. Academic and research libraries as defined in subsection C of this section shall be eligible to seek assistance from the Oklahoma Department of Libraries for purposes of applying for Schools and Libraries E-Rate Program discounts through the USAC which are available to schools and libraries.
  - C. As used in this section, "academic libraries and research libraries" means a private library, private museum or volunteer fire department that:
  - 1. Operates as a nonprofit corporation which is exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3);
    - 2. Is available for continuing education classes; and
  - 3. Is open to the public for a minimum of ten (10) hours per week with at least three computers available for use by the public.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
