PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to telecommunications services;
stating that certain academic and research libraries
are to be considered libraries for certain purposes;
making certain academic and research libraries
eligible for certain assistance; defining academic
and research libraries; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 139.111 of Title 17, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. For purposes of applying for and participating in the
federal Schools and Libraries E-Rate Program administered by the
Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC), academic and
research libraries as defined in subsection C of this section shall
be considered libraries for purposes of the definition of libraries

1 and under the requirements for schools and libraries as set forth in
2 the Schools and Libraries E-Rate Program.

3 B. Academic and research libraries as defined in subsection C
4 of this section shall be eligible to seek assistance from the
5 Oklahoma Department of Libraries for purposes of applying for
6 Schools and Libraries E-Rate Program discounts through the USAC
7 which are available to schools and libraries.

8 C. As used in this section, "academic libraries and research
9 libraries" means a private library, private museum or volunteer fire
10 department that:

11 1. Operates as a nonprofit corporation which is exempt from
12 taxation pursuant to the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the
13 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3);

14 2. Is available for continuing education classes; and

15 3. Is open to the public for a minimum of ten (10) hours per
16 week with at least three computers available for use by the public.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
