L7	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for				
L8	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,				
L 9	the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article V of the				
20	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:				
21	Section 2. The first power reserved by the people is the				
22	initiative, and eight per centum <u>percent (8%)</u> of the legal voters <u>of</u>				
23	each county of this state shall have the right to propose any				
24	legislative measure, and fifteen per centum percent (15%) of the

1	legal voters of each county of this state shall have the right to
2	propose amendments to the Constitution by petition, and every such
3	petition shall include the full text of the measure so proposed.
4	The second power is the referendum, and it may be ordered (except as
5	to laws necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
6	peace, health, or safety), either by petition signed by five per
7	centum percent (5%) of the legal voters of each county of this state
8	or by the Legislature as other bills are enacted. The ratio and per
9	centum of legal voters hereinbefore stated shall be based upon the
10	total number of votes cast at the last general election for the
11	Office of Governor.
