PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to ethics; providing that  
unintentional filing of certain inaccurate  
information shall not be considered perjury;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4263 of Title 74, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The unintentional filing of inaccurate reports, documentation or  
any other information with the Oklahoma Ethics Commission shall not  
constitute perjury as defined in Section 491 of Title 21 of the  
Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
