- C. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
- D. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise

  Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse

  Services shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
  - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
