PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to torts; permitting liability for damages committed by a trespasser; authorizing vicarious liability for person or entity that compensates trespasser; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 80.1 of Title 76, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A person who is arrested or convicted of trespass may be held liable for any damages to personal or real property while trespassing.

B. A person or entity that compensates or remunerates a person for trespassing as described in subsection A of this section, may also be held vicariously liable for any damages to personal or real property committed by the person compensated or remunerated for trespassing.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
