17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

- 1. Little Cigars. Upon cigars of all descriptions made of tobacco, or any substitute therefor, and weighing not more than three (3) pounds per thousand, fifteen and one-half (15 1/2) mills for each cigar. Provided, that the tax levied on the products coming under this paragraph shall not apply if the tax on such products is reported and paid as cigarette tax under Section 301 through 325 of this title; and
- 2. Cigars. Upon all other cigars of all descriptions made of tobacco, or any substitute therefor, and weighing more than three (3) pounds per thousand, Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per thousand. For the purpose of computing the tax, cheroots, stogies, etc., are hereby classed as cigars.
- B. The revenue from the additional tax herein levied shall be apportioned by the Oklahoma Tax Commission and transmitted to the State Treasurer who shall deposit such revenue in the General Revenue Fund.
