17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

1 to, items of tangible personal property for purposes of promoting or advertising the name of the state government entity or its programs, 2 missions, duties or functions, such as magnets, buttons, bumper 3 4 stickers, ribbons, awards, prizes, trophies, stationery, writing 5 implements, legal pad holders, book bags or similar items. 6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.302 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 8

9 For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2018, June 30, 2019, and 10 June 30, 2020, no executive branch agency, board, commission, 11 department or other entity organized within the executive branch of 12 state government shall expend any funds on nonessential travel, 13 which for purposes of this section shall include travel for any 14 member of the governing body of the entity or employees of the 15 entity to attend seminars, conferences or similar events, whether 16 conducted in state or out of state.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017. SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
