PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;
amending 57 O.S. 2011, Section 503, which relates to
the State Board of Corrections; changing procedure by
which certain board members are appointed; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 503, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 503. A. There is hereby created the State Board of
Corrections which shall be the governing board of the Department of
Corrections herein created.

B. The Board shall consist of ~~seven (7)~~ nine (9) members ~~who~~
~~shall~~ to be appointed as follows:

1. Seven members shall be appointed by the Governor with the
advice and consent of the Senate. One member shall be appointed
from each congressional district and any remaining members shall be

1 appointed from the state at large. However, when congressional
2 districts are redrawn, each member appointed prior to July 1 of the
3 year in which such modification becomes effective shall complete the
4 current term of office and appointments made after July 1 of the
5 year in which such modification becomes effective shall be based on
6 the redrawn districts. Appointments made after July 1 of the year
7 in which such modification becomes effective shall be from any
8 redrawn districts which are not represented by a board member until
9 such time as each of the modified congressional districts are
10 represented by a board member. No appointments may be made after
11 July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective if
12 such appointment would result in more than two members serving from
13 the same modified district;

14 2. One member shall be appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma
15 House of Representatives and shall be a duly elected county sheriff
16 from a county with a population that exceeds fifty thousand (50,000;
17 and

18 3. One member shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore
19 of the Oklahoma State Senate and shall be a duly elected county
20 sheriff from a county with a population that does not exceed fifty
21 thousand (50,000).

22 C. The terms of office of two members shall expire on March 15,
23 1969, and each six (6) years thereafter; the terms of two members
24 shall expire on March 15, 1971, and each six (6) years thereafter;

1 and the terms of three members shall expire on March 15, 1973, and
2 each six (6) years thereafter.

3 D. Not more than ~~four~~ five members of the Board shall be of the
4 same political party.

5 E. Any member of the Board may be removed from office in the
6 manner provided by law for the removal of officers not subject to
7 impeachment. Vacancies on the Board shall be filled for the
8 unexpired term.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
