PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to developmental disabilities;
defining terms; establishing a voucher waiver program
for caregivers of persons with developmental
disabilities; directing Developmental Disabilities
Services and Department of Human Services to
implement and maintain the program; providing for
collaboration with the Governor's Advisory Committee;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1426 of Title 10, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. As used in this section:

1. "Caregiver" means a person eighteen (18) years of age or
older who provides full-time care for a person with an intellectual
disability in the caregiver's home; and

1 2. "Person with an intellectual disability" means a person who
2 has significantly subaverage functioning, an intelligence quotient
3 (IQ) of less than 70 that manifests before eighteen (18) years of
4 age and exists concurrently with related limitations in two or more
5 of the following applicable adaptive skill areas:

- 6 a. communication,
- 7 b. self-care,
- 8 c. home living,
- 9 d. social skills,
- 10 e. use of community resources,
- 11 f. self-direction,
- 12 g. health and safety,
- 13 h. functional academics,
- 14 i. leisure, and
- 15 j. work.

16 B. Subject to the availability of funds, the Developmental
17 Disabilities Services (DDS) of the Department of Human Services
18 shall implement and maintain a voucher waiver program to provide
19 respite for caregivers of a person with an intellectual disability
20 who qualifies for Medicaid services and meets the Intermediate Care
21 Facilities for individuals with Intellectual Disability (ICF/ID)
22 level of care.

1 C. The DDS and the Department, in collaboration with the
2 Governor's Advisory Committee created by Executive Order 2015-17,
3 shall:

4 1. Establish eligibility and procedures for implementation and
5 maintenance of the voucher waiver program;

6 2. Apply for a waiver or waivers to the Centers for Medicaid
7 and Medicare Services (CMS) to maximize funding for the voucher
8 waiver program; and

9 3. Promulgate rules necessary for the voucher waiver program.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
