18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:							
19	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified							
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 158.100 of Title 17, unless							
21								
	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:							
22	A. There is hereby created the "Task Force on Foreign Entity							
23	Utility Rates".							
24	B. The Task Force shall consist of the following persons:							

1. One person appointed by the Governor;

- 2. One person appointed by the Attorney General who shall have demonstrated experience in representing the State of Oklahoma before the Oklahoma Corporation Commission in utility rate proceedings with an emphasis on electric power providers;
- 3. One person to be selected by action of a majority of the members of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission who shall have demonstrated expertise in utility rate-making and the regulation of public utilities with an emphasis on electric power providers;
- 4. Two persons appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, one of whom shall be a member of that chamber and one of whom shall represent the interests of a regulated public utility with an emphasis on electric power providers;
- 5. Two persons appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, one of whom shall be a member of that chamber and one of whom shall represent the interests of consumers with an emphasis on consumers of electric power at the retail level of service.
- C. Appointments to the Task Force shall be made not later than thirty (30) days from the effective date of this act. The Task Force shall hold an organizational meeting and shall select from among its membership a chair and vice chair. The Task Force shall hold its organizational meeting not later than thirty (30) days from

the date of the last appointment required pursuant to subsection B of this section.

- D. The Task Force shall analyze the effect of electric power utilities organized under the laws of another country or a subsidiary of such an entity and which provide electric power to commercial and residential customers in the state. The Task Force shall give emphasis to studying any possible disparity in electric utility rates authorized to be charged by such foreign enterprises.
- E. The Task Force may meet as often as required in order to perform the duties imposed upon it. The Task Force shall not be subject to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, but shall cause notice of its meetings to be posted on the website of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the Oklahoma State Senate and any other website maintained by the State of Oklahoma which is accessible and available for the posting of meeting notices by task force entities or other advisory entities.
- F. The Task Force shall be subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act, but shall not be required to release any record which would be exempt from disclosure pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act by any other government entity.
- G. The Task Force shall produce a final report not later than December 31, 2018. The report shall be provided to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the President
