- B. No apprentice shall engage in any of the practices of cosmetology or barbering except under the immediate supervision of a licensed instructor in a cosmetology or barber establishment approved by the Board for apprentice training.
- C. All apprentices must wear a badge which designates them as an apprentice and is furnished by the Board with the apprentice registration receipt.
- D. Only one apprentice No more than two apprentices may be registered to receive training in any cosmetology or barber establishment at any one time.
- E. Completion of three thousand (3,000) two thousand (2,000) hours of apprentice training in a cosmetology or barber establishment is the equivalent of one thousand five hundred (1,500) hours' training in a cosmetology or barber school and shall entitle the apprentice to take the examination.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
