PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending
63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-210, which relates to city-
county boards of health; creating a city-county board
of health with certain population limits after a
certain date; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-210, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 1-210. ~~There~~ Prior to November 1, 2018, there is hereby
created in any county of the State of Oklahoma with a population of
more than two hundred twenty-five thousand (225,000), according to
the latest Federal Decennial Census, and containing within its
boundaries a city with a population of more than one hundred fifty
thousand (150,000), according to the latest Federal Decennial
Census, a city-county board of health composed of nine (9) members.
Beginning on and after November 1, 2018, there is hereby created in

1 any county of the State of Oklahoma with a population of more than
2 two hundred twenty-five thousand (225,000), according to the latest
3 Federal Decennial Census, and containing within its boundaries a
4 city with a population of more than one hundred twenty-five thousand
5 (125,000), according to the latest Federal Decennial Census, a city-
6 county board of health composed of nine (9) members. The membership
7 of the Board shall be composed of five members appointed by the city
8 council of such city, or city commission, whichever applies, and
9 four members appointed by the board of county commissioners of such
10 county. Each member shall serve a term of six (6) years, except,
11 that of the members initially appointed by the city council, or city
12 commission, whichever applies, one member initially appointed shall
13 serve a term of two (2) years, one member initially appointed shall
14 serve a term of three (3) years, one member initially appointed
15 shall serve a term of four (4) years, one member initially appointed
16 shall serve a term of five (5) years, and one member initially
17 appointed shall serve a term of six (6) years; provided, however,
18 that in any such city having a city board of health created under
19 its charter provisions, the members of such city board of health and
20 the tenure of the city board of health members of the city-county
21 board of health shall be coterminous with the city board of Health.
22 Of the members initially appointed by the board of county
23 commissioners, one member initially appointed shall serve a term of
24 two (2) years, one member initially appointed shall serve a term of

1 three (3) years, one member initially appointed shall serve a term
2 of five (5) years, and one member initially appointed shall serve a
3 term of six (6) years. The appointing authority shall appoint new
4 members as the terms of office of its initial appointees expire.

5 Wherever a city-county board of health is now in existence, the
6 current board members shall be retained, until the termination of
7 their present appointment, by the appointing authorities.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
