7 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to state employees; providing maximum
9 salary amount for certain employees; providing
10 exceptions; providing for codification; and providing
11 an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.15C of Title 74, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Effective November 1, 2018, and for each fiscal year
17 thereafter, no state employee shall receive a salary which is
18 greater than ninety percent (90%) of the salary paid to the chief
19 executive officer of the agency, board, commission, department or
20 program in the executive branch of state government, of which the
21 employee is employed. Nothing in this Section shall apply to the
22 Oklahoma Department of Rehabilitation Services.

23 B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to physicians
24 licensed by the State Board of Medical Licensure or the State Board

1 of Osteopathic Examiners, veterinarians, psychologists, speech
2 pathologists, registered nurses, advanced practice registered
3 nurses, PhDs in the medical field, dentists, optometrists and other
4 licensed medical professionals.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
