PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to insurance; prohibiting managed care entity from imposing requirements relating to vaccination protocol; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.4.1 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A managed care entity, as defined in Section 6592 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes, may not:

1. Require a physician participating in a managed care plan to issue an immunization or vaccination protocol for an immunization or vaccination to be administered to an enrollee in the plan;

2. Limit an enrollee's benefits for immunizations or vaccinations to circumstances in which an immunization or vaccination protocol is issued;

1 3. Provide a financial incentive to a physician to issue an
2 immunization or vaccination protocol; or

3 4. Impose a financial or other penalty on a physician who
4 refused to issue an immunization or vaccination protocol.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
