C. Exemptions to the eligibility criteria in this section shall be the same as the exemption criteria for SNAP in 7 U.S.C., Section 2015(o) or Medicaid populations excluded pursuant to federal Medicaid laws and guidelines. Populations excluded from the requirements shall include those which are excluded by SNAP in 7 U.S.C., Section 2015(o) or federal Medicaid laws and guidelines. The state may adopt additional exemptions subject to agency rulemaking and federal approval.
