PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to court records; amending 22 O.S. 2011, Section 977, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 348, O.S.L. 2016 (22 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 977), which relates to records of convictions; requiring court to obtain certain information from defendant; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 2011, Section 977, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 348, O.S.L. 2016 (22 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 977), is amended to read as follows:

Section 977. A. When judgment upon a conviction is rendered, the clerk must enter the same upon the minutes, stating briefly the offense for which the conviction has been had, and must immediately

1 annex together and file the following papers, which constitute a
2 record of the action:

3 1. The indictment and a copy of the minutes of the plea or
4 demurrer;

5 2. A copy of the minutes of the trial;

6 3. The charges given or refused, and the endorsements, if any,
7 thereon; and

8 4. A copy of the judgment, which shall include a notation of
9 the month and year of birth date of the defendant and the last four
10 digits of the Social Security number of the defendant. The judgment
11 shall also contain the statutory reference to the felony crime the
12 defendant was convicted of and the date of the offense.

13 B. The court shall obtain the month and year of birth date of
14 the defendant and the last four digits of the Social Security number
15 of the defendant.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
