PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to trauma-informed care; creating the Task Force on Trauma-Informed Care; providing for membership; providing for appointment of cochairs; authorizing staff assistance; providing for duties; requiring certain report; providing for travel reimbursement; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created until January 1, 2021, the Task Force on Trauma-Informed Care.

B. The task force shall consist of twenty-two (22) members as follows:

- 1        1. One member who is an employee of the State Department of  
2 Health appointed by the Commissioner of Health;
- 3        2. One member who is an employee of the Department of Mental  
4 Health and Substance Abuse Services appointed by the Commissioner of  
5 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services;
- 6        3. One member who is an employee of the Department of Human  
7 Services appointed by the Director of the Department of Human  
8 Services;
- 9        4. One member who is an employee of the State Department of  
10 Education appointed by the State Superintendent of Public  
11 Instruction;
- 12       5. One member who is an employee of the Office of Juvenile  
13 Affairs appointed by the Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs;
- 14       6. One member who is an employee of the Council on Law  
15 Enforcement Education and Training appointed by the Director of the  
16 Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training;
- 17       7. One member who is an employee of the Oklahoma Commission on  
18 Children and Youth appointed by the Director of the Commission on  
19 Children and Youth;
- 20       8. One member who is an employee of the Oklahoma Health Care  
21 Authority appointed by the Chief Executive Officer of the Health  
22 Care Authority;
- 23       9. One member who is an employee of the Office of Attorney  
24 General appointed by the Attorney General;

1        10. Six members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the  
2 Oklahoma House of Representatives as follows:

- 3            a. one shall be an employee of Indian Health Service,
- 4            b. one shall be an employee of the Center for Integrative  
5                Research on Childhood Adversity of Oklahoma State  
6                University,
- 7            c. one shall be a representative of an association of  
8                Oklahoma physicians,
- 9            d. one shall be an officer or director of an association  
10               that identifies and promotes the development of a  
11               qualified workforce to support the emotional  
12               development of infants, toddlers and families, and
- 13           e. two shall be members of the Oklahoma House of  
14               Representatives; and

15        11. Seven members shall be appointed by the President Pro  
16 Tempore of the State Senate as follows:

- 17           a. one shall be a representative of an Oklahoma chapter  
18               of a professional association of pediatricians,
- 19           b. one shall be an employee of the University of Oklahoma  
20               Health Sciences Center's Department of Pediatrics,
- 21           c. one shall be a representative of a child advocacy  
22               organization in Oklahoma,
- 23           d. one shall be an employee of the Institute for Building  
24               Early Relationships at Oklahoma State University,

1           e.    one shall be a representative of a consortium of  
2                agencies that provide services to children and  
3                families in Oklahoma, and

4           f.    two shall be members of the State Senate.

5       C.   1.  Members shall serve at the pleasure of their appointing  
6 authorities.  A vacancy on the task force shall be filled by the  
7 original appointing authority.

8       2.  Appointments to the task force shall be made by December 31,  
9 2018.

10      3.  The Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the  
11 President Pro Tempore of the State Senate shall each designate a  
12 cochair from among the members of the task force.

13      D.  The task force may use the expertise and services of the  
14 staffs of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma  
15 State Senate.  The task force may, as necessary, seek the advice and  
16 services of experts in the field of trauma-informed care but without  
17 any reimbursement by the State of Oklahoma for any costs associated  
18 with such services.

19      E.  The task force shall study and make recommendations on a  
20 statewide, coordinated approach to preventing trauma in children,  
21 particularly the adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) associated  
22 with negative health and well-being outcomes across the life span.  
23 The task force shall also identify appropriate interventions and  
24

1 supports for children, youth and their families who have experienced  
2 or are at risk of experiencing trauma.

3 F. The task force shall publish its findings and  
4 recommendations by January 1, 2021, including recommendations for  
5 any resulting legislation.

6 G. Travel reimbursement for members of the task force who are  
7 legislators shall be made pursuant to Section 456 of Title 74 of the  
8 Oklahoma Statutes, and travel reimbursement for members of the task  
9 force who are state or university employees shall be reimbursed by  
10 the respective employing entity.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
