- purposes of physical fitness and wellness. Such leave shall not be charged to annual or sick leave accumulations.
- C. Eligibility to participate under the provisions of this section shall be limited to those full-time classified employees and regular unclassified employees who meet standards as established in rules promulgated pursuant to this section and have received approval from their respective agency director or designee.
- D. The administrative leave authorized by this section shall be limited to no more than three (3) hours per week.
- E. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall promulgate rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with the provision of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma

  Constitution.
