PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to veterans and military; authorizing administrative leave for certain employees for volunteer service; specifying criteria for leave; providing time limitation; directing the Executive Director to establish certain guidelines; amending 44 O.S. 2011, Section 21.1, which relates to Military Department personnel; authorizing administrative leave for certain employees for volunteer service; specifying criteria for leave; providing time limitation; directing the Adjutant General to establish certain guidelines; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 450 of Title 72, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Any employee of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs may be granted administrative leave with pay for volunteer service activities, under such terms and limitations as the Executive

1 Director may establish, in service to veterans or dependents of
2 veterans in the State of Oklahoma, which activities meet one or more
3 of the following criteria:

4 1. The activity is directly related to the Department's
5 mission;

6 2. The activity is sponsored or sanctioned by or in partnership
7 with the Department; or

8 3. The activity will enhance the development or skills of the
9 employee in his or her current position.

10 B. Leave shall be as brief as permitted under the circumstances
11 and shall not support an activity otherwise prohibited by law while
12 in a duty status.

13 C. The Executive Director shall establish guidelines for
14 approval of administrative leave for volunteer service authorized
15 hereunder which balances the Department's goals and operations and
16 ensures that each is conducted efficiently and effectively.

17 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2011, Section 21.1, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 21.1 A. Personnel appointed as state employees in the
20 Military Department shall be in the unclassified service of the
21 state. The Adjutant General may grant leave to state civilian
22 employees consistent with the rules governing the federal workforce
23 in support of the National Guard.

1 B. Any employee of the Military Department of the State of
2 Oklahoma may be granted administrative leave with pay for volunteer
3 service activities, under such terms and limitations as the Adjutant
4 General may establish, in service that meets one or more of the
5 following criteria:

6 1. The activity is directly related to the Department's
7 mission;

8 2. The activity is sponsored or sanctioned by or in partnership
9 with the Department; or

10 3. The activity will enhance the development or skills of the
11 employee in his or her current position.

12 C. Leave granted pursuant to subsection B of this section shall
13 be as brief as permitted under the circumstances and shall not
14 support an activity otherwise prohibited by law while in a duty
15 status.

16 D. The Adjutant General shall establish guidelines for approval
17 of administrative leave for volunteer service authorized pursuant to
18 subsection B of this section which balances the Department's goals
19 and operations and ensures that each is conducted efficiently and
20 effectively.

21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
