8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority  
9 Act; setting forth certain audit procedures;  
10 providing for certain peer-to-peer review process;  
11 requiring Authority to allow requests for hearings;  
12 requiring Authority to conduct certain training  
13 seminars; providing for moratorium on certain audit;  
14 providing for codification; and declaring an  
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1010.14 of Title 56, unless  
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. Not less than thirty (30) days before conducting a program  
21 integrity audit of any provider, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority  
22 or its designee shall notify the provider in writing of the  
23 impending program integrity audit.

24 B. The Authority shall provide for a peer-to-peer review  
process of the initial program integrity audit report and the  
preliminary findings of the program integrity audit before a request  
for informal consideration or a request for a formal appeal.

1 C. The Authority shall allow any applicant, recipient or  
2 provider to request a hearing up to forty-five (45) calendar days  
3 following the notification by the Authority of the adverse decision.

4 D. With the goal of reducing Medicaid billing and coding  
5 errors, the Authority shall hold annual training seminars with each  
6 of the following entities:

- 7 1. A statewide association representing allopathic physicians;
- 8 2. A statewide association representing osteopathic physicians;
- 9 3. A statewide association representing dentists;
- 10 4. A statewide association representing nursing homes;
- 11 5. A statewide association representing hospitals; and
- 12 6. A statewide association representing pharmacists.

13 Training seminars shall be as comprehensive as possible and  
14 include a detailed written explanation of probability sampling  
15 methods used and extrapolation methods used.

16 E. After the effective date of this act, the Authority shall  
17 not perform a program integrity audit of a provider until after the  
18 training seminar for that class of provider has been completed.

19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
