1. Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with an average daily membership (ADM) of under 100;

- 2. A maximum of Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of one hundred fifty (150) or less but more than one hundred (100);
- 3. A maximum of Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$95,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of two hundred (200) or less but more than one hundred fifty-one (150);
- 4. A maximum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of two hundred-fifty (250) or less but more than two hundred (200);
- 5. A maximum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with an average daily membership (ADM) of two hundred fifty (250) or less;
- 6. A maximum of One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of seven hundred fifty (750) or less but more than two hundred fifty (250);
- 7. A maximum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars

 (\$120,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with

 an ADM of one thousand five hundred (1,500) or less but more than

 seven hundred fifty (750);

8. A maximum of One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$130,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of three thousand (3,000) or less but more than one thousand five hundred (1,500);

- 9. A maximum of One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of six thousand five hundred (6,500) or less but more than three thousand (3,000); and
- 10. A maximum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars

 (\$150,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with

 an ADM of more than six thousand five hundred (6,500).
- B. A school district board of education may enter into a new contract or renew a contract with a superintendent that exceeds the maximum compensation amounts provided for in subsection A of this section provided that no state appropriated funds are used for any amount above the maximum amount allowed.
- C. The State Board of Education, upon written application by the school district board of education, may approve a waiver of the maximum compensation amounts for any district or districts with an ADM of fifteen thousand (15,000) or more.
- D. For the purposes of this section, "compensation" shall mean base salary and fringe benefits.
- E. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
