9	definitions; providing insurance requirements for a bicycle sharing company; providing requirements for

12	declaring an emergency.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 12-710 of Title 47, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. As used in this section:
19	1. "Bicycle sharing company" means an entity that makes
20	dockless bicycles available for private use by reservation through
21	an online application, software or website;
22	2. "Dockless bicycle" means a bicycle, including an electric
23	bicycle, that is self-locking and that is not connected to a docking
24	station;

- 3. "Local governmental entity" means a county, municipality or
 other local governmental entity or subdivision; and
- 4. "User" means a person who reserves a dockless bicycle
 through a bicycle sharing company's online application, software or
 website.

- B. A person or entity may not operate a bicycle sharing company in this state unless the person or entity maintains a current and valid combined single-limit policy of commercial general liability insurance coverage in the amount of at least Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.
- C. Each dockless bicycle made available for reservation by a bicycle sharing company must:
- 14 1. Meet the requirements for bicycles set forth in this article;
 - 2. Obtain a permit from the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department;
 - 3. Be available for reservation twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week;
 - 4. Prominently display the bicycle company's trade address;
- 5. Display an e-mail address or a telephone number at which a user may contact the bicycle sharing company for customer support; and

6. Be lawfully parked when not in use.

- D. A bicycle sharing company must provide through its online application, software or website:
- 1. Notification that a rider of a dockless bicycle must operate the dockless bicycle in compliance with state and local law; and
- 2. An interface that enables a user to notify the bicycle sharing company of an issue relating to the safety or maintenance of a dockless bicycle.
 - E. The Department shall:
- 1. Issue a permit to each applicant that presents proof, in a form prescribed by the Department, that the applicant meets the requirements for a bicycle sharing company set forth in this act, and proof of insurance required by this act and pays to the Department an annual permit fee of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00); and
- 2. Promulgate rules as needed to implement the provisions of this act.
- F. The authority of the Department shall be limited to permitting and regulation of bicycle sharing companies to ensure compliance by the bicycle sharing companies with the provisions of this act and shall not include jurisdiction to adjudicate private causes of action arising from the provisions of bicycle rental and use.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 12-711 of Title 47, unless there 3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the regulation, 4 5 licensing or permitting of bicycle sharing companies for the provisions of bicycle rentals and use is within the exclusive 6 jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and 7 any rules promulgated by the Department consistent with the act. No 8 9 political subdivision of the state may impose a tax on, or require a 10 license for, a bicycle sharing company for the provision of bicycle 11 rental and use or subject a bicycle sharing company to the political 12 subdivision's rate requirement, entry requirement, operational 13 requirement or other requirements. SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018. 14 15 SECTION 4.
