Supp. 2016, 18 Section 63.3), is amended to read as follows: 19 20 Section 63.3. The Oklahoma Veterans Commission shall perform all acts necessary or proper to afford emergency, temporary and 21 permanent relief and assistance to all honorably discharged ex-22 service persons of all wars of the United States of America and to 23

their dependents, and shall perform such other duties as may be

prescribed by law. The Commission shall promulgate rules and regulations, in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, for the operation and maintenance of the Department of Veterans Affairs; provided, however, in all cases priority and preference shall always be given to disabled or diseased ex-service persons. The members of the Commission shall be reimbursed for necessary travel as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act. In addition to its other powers and duties as herein provided, the Commission shall have the following specific powers and duties which shall, however, not be deemed to be exclusive:

1. To organize itself by the election of a Chairman Chair, Vice Chairman Chair and Secretary, who shall perform the duties required of them by the rules and regulations, but shall receive no extra compensation therefor, and to provide for the time and place of meetings of the Commission;

- 2. To appoint the Director of the Department of Veterans

 Affairs and submit a list of nominees to the Governor, to serve as

 both the Director of the Department and as cabinet secretary for the

 cabinet area consisting of the Department and other related veterans

 entities as provided in subsection B of Section 10.3 of Title 74 of

 the Oklahoma Statutes, and to determine the salary for such

 position;
- 3. To remove the person serving as Director of the Department and as cabinet secretary for the cabinet area consisting of the

        Section 10.3. A. Within forty-five (45) days of assuming

    office, each Governor may create a cabinet system for the executive

- 1 Veterans Affairs, its institutions and other executive agencies, boards, commissions and institutions which are related to veterans. 2 The Governor's cabinet shall be in effect until the Legislature 3 supersedes each specific cabinet area or department by providing by law for specific cabinet areas or departments, or removes by law the 5 authority of the Governor to create a cabinet area. At any time 6 during the Governor's term of office, the cabinet may be modified at 7 the sole discretion of the Governor subject to Senate confirmation 9 as provided by subsection B of this section.
 - B. The Governor shall appoint, with the advice and consent of the Senate, a Secretary to head each cabinet area. The; provided, the Secretary appointee for the cabinet area consisting of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs and other related veterans entities shall be:

- 1. Be an honorably discharged veteran and be eligible to receive benefits from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs;
- 2. Be appointed, with the advice and consent of the Senate,
 from a list of three qualified persons submitted to the Governor by
 the Oklahoma Veterans Commission;
- 3. Be subject to removal upon a vote of not less than two-thirds of the members of the Oklahoma Veterans Commission; and
- 4. Also serve as the Director of the Oklahoma Department of

 Veterans Affairs. Provided, the person serving in such position on

the effective date of this act shall continue to serve without being reappointed as provided in this subsection, until such time as there is a vacancy in such position.

- <u>C.</u> A cabinet Secretary may be appointed as a position funded by the Office of the Governor from funds available to that office, or appointed as a cabinet Secretary from among the agency heads within the cabinet area. The cabinet Secretaries shall:
- 1. Advise the Governor of any policy changes or problems within the area they represent;
- 2. Advise the entities represented of any policy changes or problems as directed by the Governor; and
- 3. Coordinate information gathering for the Legislature as requested.

Except as otherwise provided in subsection B of this section, the cabinet Secretaries shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor, however, the appointment or removal of a cabinet Secretary who is also an agency head shall not otherwise affect the status of the other duties of the agency head. Whenever a Secretary position becomes vacant, the Governor shall appoint a successor within thirty (30) calendar days pursuant to the provisions of subsection B of this section. If the Legislature is not in session at the time of appointment it shall be subject to the advice and consent of the Senate upon convening of the next regular session of the Legislature.
